Discover Egypt's journey over 12 centuries, as Jews, Christians and Muslims transformed this ancient land. It is a story charting the change from a polytheistic to a monotheistic world. The exhibition begins in 30 BCE when Egypt became a province of the Roman Empire after the death of Cleopatra and Mark Anthony, and continues until 1171 CE when the rule of the Islamic Fatimid dynasty came to an end.
